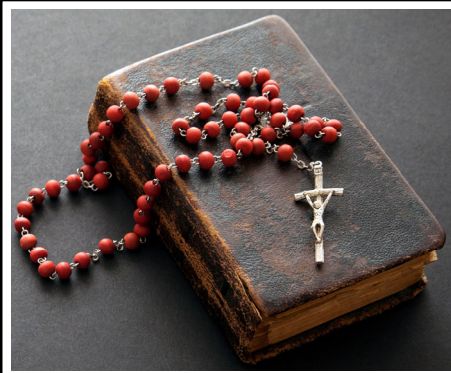


You can help pay for the altar candle with a donation of \$25.00. It can be in Loving memory of or in Honor of your loved ones. Please call the office to reserve your date.
