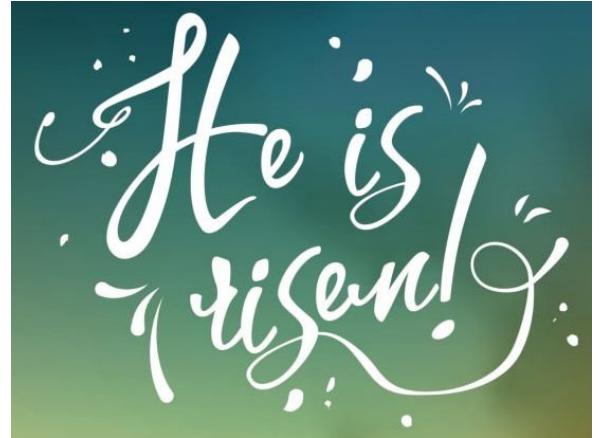

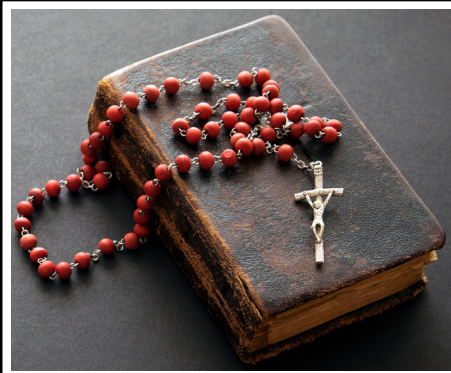



BAA 2024 UPDATE: Learning from Our History, and Shaping Our Future

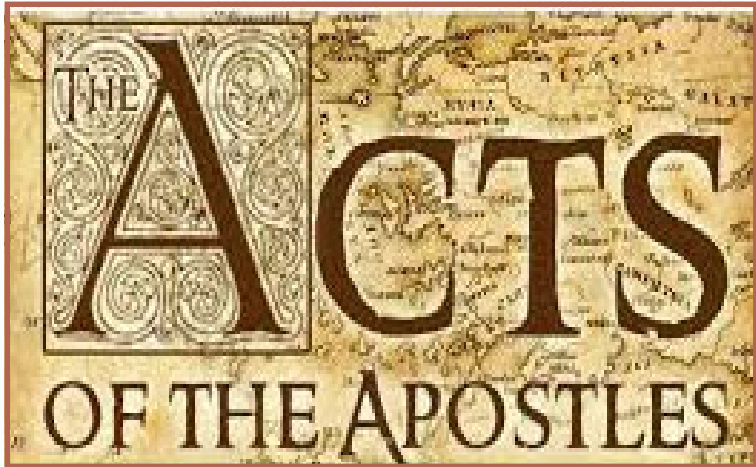

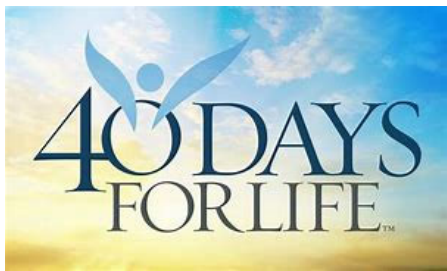
Court 2588 is ready to kick off a new season!

Our 40 Days for Life Spring Campaign begins February 14 and ends March 24!

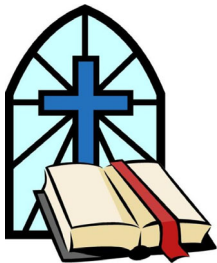
