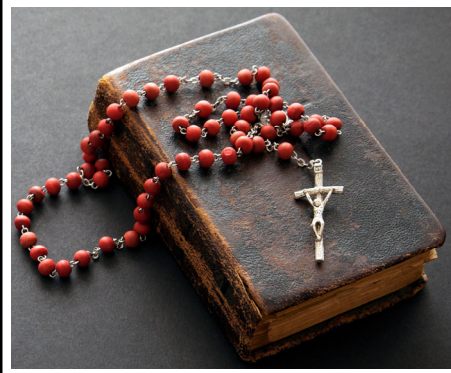

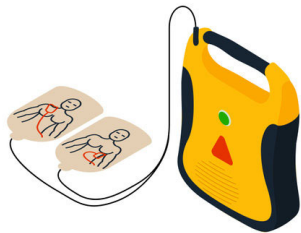

Our parish goal is \$64,592 and so far 124 families have pledges/donated \$43,599. We still have a LONG way to go.

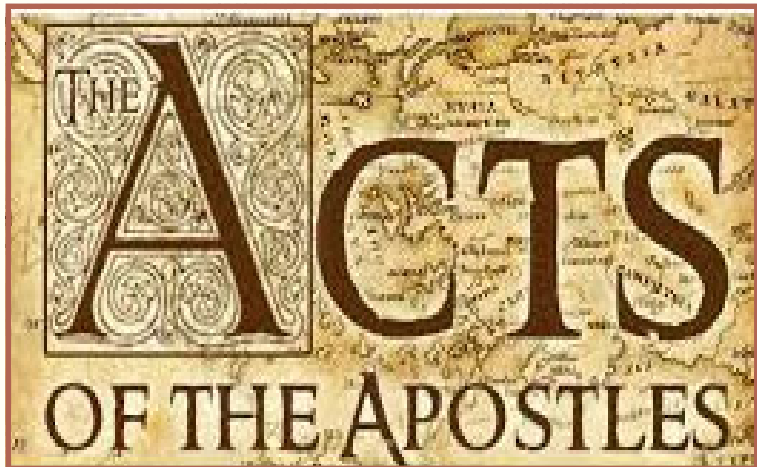

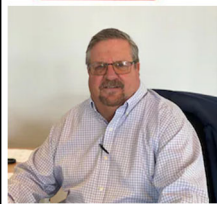
